About Students

We are distinctive among higher education institutions in the UK, in that we teach primarily at a distance and have no academic prerequisites for admission to undergraduate modules. As long as applicants are aged (usually) 16 or over and live in the UK or another EU country (some modules are available in many other parts of the world), the only factors which affect the offer of an undergraduate place are date of application and the number of places available. Over a third of our UK undergraduates have entry qualifications lower than those normally required by other UK universities. We have around 126,000 UK undergraduates; 8,300 postgraduates and 7,800 non-UK-based students studying OU UG or PG modules. More than 21,000 students of our UG and PG students have declared disabilities. We also have more than 500 OU students studying Overseas versions of OU modules.

Notes on the data

The 2016 reporting period is for the academic year 2014/15. The data in this report covers the years 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/13, 2013/14 and 2014/15.

The scale of many of the bar charts has been adjusted to show differences more clearly.

Participation

Data for undergraduate, new undergraduate and postgraduate UK students, all non-UK students, Overseas students¹, Research students and ITE students is reported.

Headcount data for 'All students' means UG + PG, where each student is counted only once, even if they study at both UG and PG level.

Currency is headcount registered at one third of the way through the module for all UG and PG OU modules. The proportions given for student Ethnic groups are of the total number whose ethnicity are known.

Module completion

Data for undergraduate and postgraduate UK students is reported in this document. Data for non-UK and Overseas students are shown separately in Excel spreadsheets. The currency for completions is student funded Full Time Equivalents (FTE120180)².

Academic attainment

Data for undergraduate UK students is reported.

The currency for attainment is student funded Full Time Equivalents (FTE120180).

Attainment for students on level 1 modules is measured by the number/proportion of completers that passed their module

Attainment for students on level 2 and 3 modules is measured by the number/proportion of those that passed who achieved a good pass. A good pass is defined as distinction and grade 2 pass or distinction and merit pass.

Attainment for students on PG modules is measured by the number/proportion of students of those that passed who achieve a good pass. A good pass is defined as an overall module score of 70% or above.

Withdrawal

Withdrawal from the programme can occur at any stage after registration and it may be due to academic or personal reasons. In the report withdrawals refer to ITE or research students. In both cases, they represent failure to achieve the intended outcome – QTS certificate for ITE students, or a research degree for research students.

Additional student data by OU region/nation and by OU faculty is available to staff to download in Excel files. Additional student data for non-UK students and Overseas students is also available in Excel files.

¹ Robust data is only available at the moment for Overseas students by gender and age



Chart 1³: Distribution of all Undergraduate UK students by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 3⁶: Completion rate for all Undergraduate UK students by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15







Chart 5¹⁰: Pass rate for all UK students on level 1 modules by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15







Chart 7: Distribution of all Undergraduate UK students by disability in 2014/15




The number of UG students declaring a disability increased again this year. The proportion of students that this number represents has also risen again, from 14.6% to 16.9% of the total UG UK population.

The number of new UG students declaring a disability increased this year. The proportion of students that this number represents has also risen from 12.4% to 15.6% of the total new UG UK population.



The completion rate for students with disabilities has fallen for the fifth year running and is now at 57.4%, and remains 10.9 percentage points behind non-disabled students.



The completion rate for disabled students has decreased to below 50% this year, whilst that of non-disabled students has also decreased. The completion rate gap for disabled students has widened to 8.6 percentage points lower than that for non-disabled students.



Chart 11: Pass rate for students on level 1 modules, by disability, 2010/11 to 2014/15







Chart 13: Distribution of all UK Undergraduate ethnic minority students, 2010/11 to 2014/15











Chart 17: Pass rate of students on level 1 modules, by grouped ethnicity, 2010/11 to 2014/15







Chart 19: Distribution of all Undergraduate UK students, by gender, 2014/15









Chart 23: Pass rate for students on level 1 modules, by gender, 2010/11 to 2014/15









Chart 27: Attainment rate for UK Postgraduate students, by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15















Chart 33: Attainment rate of Postgraduate students by grouped ethnicity, 2010/11 to 2014/15









Chart 36: Good pass rate for Postgraduate students, by gender, 2010/11 to 2014/15







Chart 38: Completion rate for all students by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15











Chart 42: Completion rates for all UK students, by grouped ethnicity, 2010/11 to 2014/15







Chart 44: Completion rate for all students, by gender, 2010/11 to 2014/15







Chart 46: Distribution of all non-UK students, by disability, 2014/15







Chart 48: Distribution of non-UK students, by gender, in 2014/15





Chart 49: Distribution of Overseas students by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 50: Distribution of Overseas students, by gender, in 2014/15





Chart 51: Distribution of Full-time Research students, by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 52: Headcount of full-time active research students for the year and proportion of total, by disability, 2014/15





Chart 53: Headcount of full-time active research students for the year and proportion of total, by ethnicity, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 54: Headcount of full-time active research students for the year and proportion of total, by gender, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 55: Headcount of part-time active research students for the year and proportion of total, by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 56: Headcount of part-time active research students for the year and proportion of total, by disability, 2014/15





Chart 57: Headcount of part-time active research students for the year and proportion of total, by ethnicity, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 58: Headcount of part-time active research students for the year and proportion of total, by gender, 2010/11 to 2014/15








Chart 60: Withdrawal count for research students and withdrawal rate for the year, proportion of total, by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 61: Headcount of active research students for the year and proportion of total, by disability, in 2014/15







Chart 63: Headcount of active research students for the year and proportion of total, by ethnicity, 2010/11 to 2014/15



Chart 64: Withdrawal count for research students and withdrawal rate for the year, proportion of total, by ethnicity, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 65: Headcount of active research students for the year and proportion of total, by gender, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 66: Withdrawal count for research students and withdrawal rate for the year, proportion of total, by gender, 2010/11 to 2014/15





Chart 67: Headcount of active ITE students for the year and proportion of total, by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15



Chart 68: Withdrawal count for ITE students and withdrawal rate for the year, proportion of total, by age, 2010/11 to 2014/15



Chart 69: Headcount of active ITE students for the year and proportion of total, by disability 2014/15



Chart 71: Headcount of active ITE students for the year and proportion of total, by ethnicity, 2010/11 to 2014/15




Chart 72: Withdrawal count for ITE students and withdrawal rate for the year, proportion of total, by ethnicity, 2010/11 to 2014/15



Chart 73: Headcount of active ITE students for the year and proportion of total, by gender, 2010/11 to 2014/15


